## SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS FROM AXPEF

⌘ AT THE meeting of the trustees of the Alpha Chi Rho Educational Foundation, Inc., on September 25, 1961, each member voted "that a cash award of \$100 shall be paid to each resident chapter of the Fraternity of Alpha Chi Rho whose scholastic average for the academic year 1961-1962 exceeds the all men's average of the university or college where the chapter is located."

Just two weeks before, in Berkeley, California, Paul K. Addams, Vice-President of AXPEF had delivered similar checks to the representatives of seven Chapters which had qualified for the award during the year 1960-61.

The Chapters which earned the award are Phi Alpha, Lafayette College; Alpha Phi, Purdue University; Phi Iota, Allegheny College; Phi Psi, Trinity College; Eta Phi, Gettysburg College; Phi Nu, Dartmouth College; Phi Kappa, University of Illinois; Zeta Phi, Clarkson College of Technology and Phi Lambda, Pennsylvania State University.

No awards (nor photos) were made to Zeta Phi and Phi Lambda at the Convention because the records had not been received in time.

Brother Addams, a past National President and winner of last year's "Alpha Chi Rho Man of the Year" Award, congratulated the chapters which won but pointed out that it was a decrease from the number winning the previous year, and urged all chapters to lay greater stress on scholarship activities.
