## Alum Board Update

From the Graduate Board, Pete Voss, Class of 1979:

As we begin 2012 with much anticipation of another great year, we remember 2011 as an excellent year for the Phi Kappa chapter. The House has not looked this good in years thanks to a number of improvements in the latter half of the year. We have replaced virtually all of the windows in the house except for the French Doors—nearly a \$50,000 investment. In addition, we rebuilt the main stairs from the first to the second floor with new oak stair treads, new risers and new structural wood under the stairs for strengthening and stabilizing. The second floor landing will be refinished over Spring Break, as will the spindles and flat oak that is on the west side of the stairway. Furthermore, the second floor main bathroom was also revamped and upgraded with new plumbing and bathroom fixtures, the second floor hallway carpeting was replaced, and the library wood floors and the dining room tables were both refinished. Whoa, I am out of breath just talking about all those improvements.

What you see here are examples that the Phi Kappa Campaign "Building for the Next Century" is in full swing and will continue for the next few years. All it takes is a lot of energy and funds. Speaking of energy, Brad LaPayne, Class of 1976, has done an amazing job coordinating all of the upgrades mentioned. He was named "Graduate Brother of the Year for 2011" at Homecoming this past October. The Building Campaign raised funds approaching \$200,000 since its inception two years ago. I call on all Brothers to continue to help us out to keep the momentum going. The Undergrads are doing well and growing in membership every year with 20 pledges this past semester.

Please remember your great days at Alpha Chi Rho and help us continue to grow and enrich the lives of Crow men just like we experienced in our day.


