O. L. McCaskill, professor of law at the university since 1926, is retiring from the faculty on September 1. He reached the age of 68, the maximum retiring age, last December 6.

Succeeding Mr. McCaskill on the faculty will be Edward W. Cleary, formerly active in law practice in Jacksonville, and more recently a lieutenant in the Navy.
