♀ THE TOTAL enrollment reached 19,962 students of whom 1,446 are on the Chicago campus.

Fraternity averages for the spring semester of 1946 reached the highest peak since World War I. The semester average was 3.5038 for university men and 3.5886 for the fraternity men.

According to E. F. Stafford, dean of men, this high average was reached because returning veterans have serious objectives and a determination to achieve good scholarship, and the Interfraternity Council raised the initiation requirement from a three-point to 3.2 and established prizes and trophies for the recognition of scholarship by the fraternities.

Fifty-two fraternities are again active on the campus. Five fraternities have rented annexes to house their large memberships.
