⚡ AN UNDERGRADUATE registration of 16,917 and a graduate registration of 2,238 bring the total number of students to 19,155 on the Urbana campus as the four-day period came to an end, G. P. Tuttle reported.

"Registration this semester has generally been handled better than last year when 18,050 registered," President George D. Stoddard stated.

Of 2,311 University freshmen who wrote rhetoric placement examinations, 48 will be granted exemption from rhetoric I and given three hours' credit toward graduation, C. W. Roberts, associate professor of English, has announced.

Of the 2,311 writing the test, 1,244 less than wrote the exam last year, 724 will be denied admission to rhetoric I and will enroll in rhetoric zero.

Fraternity rushing ended for the largest number of men ever to participate as 1,400 rushees completed their last round of "dates" in forty-eight fraternities.

Miriam A. Sheldon, Millbrook, N. Y., and Washington, D. C., has been appointed dean of women by authority of the executive committee of the board of trustees, President George D. Stoddard announced recently.
