on campus have definite church affiliations or preferences. Leading the list of 41 faiths indicated were Methodists, totaling 3,348. Others were: Catholic, 2,856; Presbyterian, 1,967; Jewish, 1,924; Lutheran, 1,332; Baptist, 857; Christian, 686; Episcopal, 538; and Congregational, 508. President George D. Stoddard and John O. Moseley, president of the University of Nevada, were principal speakers for the first interfraternity week on campus. The purpose of the week is "to climax the pledge training period for freshmen who were pledged in the fall, to provide special information and assistance to those fraternity men who carry the responsibilities of administrative positions, and to

provide total beneficial and inspirational meetings for all of the fraternity men, pledges and actives."
