⌘ THE GENERAL ELECTRIC COMPANY has made the University a gift of a \$90,000 television transmitter.

A year or 18 months will elapse however, before transmissions will begin. The transmitter will be located at Robert Allerton park, 25 miles from the studio on the main campus.

President Stoddard explained that negotiations for the gift had been carried on by Dean William L. Everitt of the College of Engineering and Dean Wilbur Schramm of the Division of Communications.

The president added: "This is a long step toward establishing University of Illinois television broadcasts. We are extremely grateful to the General Electric company."
