

Michael Eugene Kellerman, "**Spike**", passed away on November 19, 2019 in his home in Pinckneyville, IL. He was 66.

Spike was born on September 6, 1953 in Pinckneyville, a son of Milton and Theresa (Waier) Kellerman.
