# **Undergraduate Chapter Update**

The Spring 2023 Semester was the first in which our new Phi Kappa Colony ran itself, without an officer of the National Fraternity onsite. The Brothers maintained the Chapter House in good condition, held weekly meetings to plan and implement various activities, and fulfilled all the requirements to remain in good standing with the University.

Some of the key Spring 2023 activities included: (a) Philanthropy – Pie A Crow on the Quad to raise money for Habitat for Humanity. In return for a donation, students were able to throw a whipped cream pie in the face of a brave member of their choice. This had the added bonus of being a very public event, which increased our exposure on campus.; (b) Sports – the Colony formed an intramural flag football team, which was not only a good bonding activity, but also got our name out in the Greek and General UofI community; and (c) Brotherhood – the Colony held a Brother Olympics of weightlifting, basketball, and running games.

Although Spring is generally the slow season for recruitment, the undergrads independently ran several rush events and added three new members to the Colony. They began planning for the main Rush season in the Fall and are continuing these discussions over the Summer. Now that they have some recruiting experience under their belts, they are analyzing the various factors that they experienced last year and are geared up for a strong Fall 2023 Rush season!

The first big day of the Fall Semester is Quad Day. It will be on August 20<sup>th</sup> and is the first and most important day of the Fall Rush Season. This is the day when the undergrads will man a table on the Quad, introduce themselves and the Colony to the U of I community, and gather as many names of prospective members as possible. After that, the next few weeks will see an aggressive effort to convert as many prospective members as possible into Alpha Chi Rho postulates.

The new AXP Phi Kappa Colony has its first two graduates, Brother Matt Chaney and Brother Robert Ferrer.

- Matt Chaney, our re-founding President, graduated with a Bachelors degree in Health Communications; Matt served as President for the SP22-FA22 semesters and on the Exec Board in the SP23 semester. He was an integral part in the re-founding of Alpha Chi Rho at Illinois. He is primarily looking for a job in healthcare administration, but has also applied to some marketing, HR, and logistics roles because of his background.
- Robert Ferrer graduated with a Bachelors degree in Political Science. Robert joined in the Fall '22 semester and previously served as the Fraternity's Social Media Chair. He is looking for a position that is not too permanent, as he plans to apply to law school. His immediate employment plans are to either do volunteer work or work as a paralegal.
