The Phi Kappa Annual Meetings, both the Building Association and the Graduate Chapter, were held at the Chapter House on Saturday, August 5, 2023.

Building Association meeting highlights: Overall, the physical House is in relatively good shape. We continue to update, repair and improve it as we continue the transition from housing renters to housing the Phi Kappa Chapter. The mortgage was refinanced with improved financial conditions and the overall value of the property continues to increase. We do need Undergraduate Brothers to occupy the House (13 is our breakeven number). Various financial options including out-of-house Brother dues and fundraising were discussed.
