Undergraduate Chapter Update

Hello Brothers,

The Graduate Chapter and the National Fraternity have made the difficult decision to temporarily disband the Phi Kappa Colony at the University of Illinois. Starting the colony under Covid restrictions and an earlier move back into the house than anticipated proved to be too much of a headwind for the fledgling group. Although we recruited a number of excellent young men, the colony never gained the momentum necessary to carry itself forward toward full Chapter status. The Building Association has secured a lease with DKE, which will provide the cash flow necessary to keep the house in order until we can mount a new effort at recolonization. Our intent is to try again in a few years with the knowledge from this experience and a better set of circumstances on campus. We look forward to once again making the Phi Kappa Chapter home for future Crows on the U of I campus.

The Graduate Chapter has and will continue to work closely with National and the U of I Office of Fraternity Affairs in preparation for our future re-colonization effort.
